Students are exposed to the basic positions, rhythms, coordination and concepts of ballet in a fun, creative and focused learning environment. Students also enjoy dance-related activities and learn about the art of ballet by watching videos of inspiring dancers, listening to stories or drawing.

Students are exposed to the fundamentals of ballet, including how dancers dress and wear their hair for class as well as the importance of healthy nutrition. In order to achieve the beautiful posture of a dancer, students learn the concepts of stretching, abdominal control and coordination. They also learn the basic exercises that comprise a ballet *barre* and center floor work. Musicality, expressiveness, grace, focus and self-discipline are encouraged at all times. Students who stay for the full day participate in dance-related activities including other forms of dance, drama, music and how these are related to the art of being a dancer.
